

**Central Pennsylvania Basketball Officials Association
December 5th, 2004, Susquehanna Township High School**

The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:35 p.m.

President, Jim Morey, posed the question to the members who officiate on the boys' side if they would be willing to work both the junior varsity and varsity games as a crew of three.

Donnie Eppley, Mid-Penn and non-PIAA Assignor, addressed the association regarding several issues. He reminded us to contact our partners prior to the contest and to fill out game reports. If you are the official who called the technical foul, you are the one who is responsible for filling out the report. If you have a problem accepting your assignments, he said to contact him directly.

As for non-PIAA issues, he reminded us that CYO has kept the rule where the coaches must remain seated on the bench. Also, he stated that PIAA assignments take precedence over non-PIAA assignments.

He informed us that on December 17th, 2004, there will be a Mid-Penn Conference meeting. If you have any issues or concerns, please let Donnie know so they can be addressed at this meeting. Issues that he will be bringing up are security to and from the site and parking.

Next year the Mid-Penn Conference will institute a pilot program using a cash card to deposit money earned while officiating. PNC Bank will be working with select schools where money will be deposited into an official's savings account.

It was clarified that you only need to double check with the AD if there is a question regarding game times.

Next, Jim Morey, presented the two selections for possible CPBOA logos. Option #1, the "spaceship" logo was unanimously approved through a vote by the membership. This logo will be used for a variety of items such as shirts, letterhead, and banquet favors.

It was reported that there are approximately 10 extra black jackets available for purchase.

The 50/50 for today was \$58. Tim Hughes, Treasurer, reminded us that dues are due and are \$25.
