- Results of inactive/active policy : #1 was accepted which states:
After going officially inactive with the PIAA and the chapter, the official will
 - ❖ Not work that year
 - ❖ Not work the play-offs that year
 - ❖ Not receive a rating that year
 - ❖ Next year may work at the same regular season level that they worked
 - ❖ Next year may work in districts if chosen (name placed at the bottom of the list)
 - ❖ Next year will not be eligible to work in state play-offs due to a lack of ratings from the previous year

Please note: the official must pay PIAA and association dues and notify the chapter of his/her intent to be inactive so that the proper form can be filed with the PIAA
